Question Words

When you are asked a question, pay attention to the **question word** so that you can give a correct answer.

Question Words

Who asks about a person.

What asks for facts about something.

When asks about time.

Where asks about the place something happened.

How asks in what way something happened.

Why asks for a reason. *Why* questions often need longer answers.

Question: **When** could you come?

Answer: I could come at nine o'clock.

Question: **Why** did the wagon tip?

Answer: The children were in the middle. Then one of them moved to the right. The extra weight on that side made it tip.
